In 2025, Safe Haven created real moments of safety, connection, and healing. We facilitated 964 supervised visitation and safe exchange appointments, ensuring families could come together in a secure, supportive setting when it mattered most. Through this work, we served 135 parents, helping rebuild trust, strengthen parent child bonds, and lay the foundation for healthier futures. Every visit was a step forward for families choosing stability, accountability, and hope.

Beyond the numbers, Safe Haven's work often takes place in complex and high-risk family situations. In 2024-2025, 52.5% of participating parents had active domestic violence orders, reinforcing the critical need for supervised, neutral spaces where children's safety is never compromised. Safe Haven provides that stability by creating an environment grounded in trauma-informed care, clear boundaries, and consistency. This approach allows families to move forward with accountability while prioritizing protection, emotional well-being, and long-term healing.




